

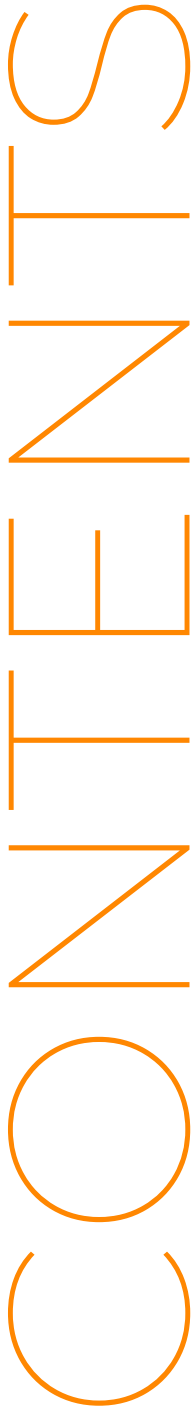

# INTRODUCTION FROM THE DIRECTOR

---

The second year of the Tobacco Endgame CRE has been an exciting and eventful year in tobacco control and endgame policy. Australian tobacco control policy has started moving in the right direction with the federal health minister, the Hon Mark Butler, announcing [new tobacco control measures](#) that continue incremental intensification of existing policies. These include extending current bans on fruit and confectionary flavoured cigarettes to menthol and other flavours, refreshing pictorial pack health warnings with new messages, and extending plain packaging features (unattractive colour and health messages) to the cigarette stick paper. Other policies include standardising the pack size and filters to prevent tobacco industry use of these measures as marketing ploys and methods to circumvent flavour bans. These new measures indicate a renewed political commitment to addressing smoking in Australia and are welcomed by our CRE.

A key event internationally has been the [passing of the Smokefree Environments and Regulated Products \(Smoked Tobacco\) Amendment Bill](#) in Aotearoa (New Zealand) on 13 December 2022. This legislation establishes Aotearoa's global leadership in tobacco policy by implementing an integrated package of measures that includes a mandatory very low nicotine content standard for smoked tobacco products (maximum of 0.8mg/g tobacco), a very large reduction in the number of tobacco retail outlets (at least 90% reduction) and a smokefree generation law that bans the sale of smoked tobacco products to anyone born after 2008. This monumental achievement started with the Tupeka Kore goal driven by Māori public health leaders, supported by local tobacco control research and advocacy, and culminating in a final package of measures that will facilitate Aotearoa's transition to Smokefree status. The Tobacco Endgame CRE is fortunate to benefit from our close collaboration with our New Zealand members who have been at the forefront of much of the research that has informed these policy innovations, including [modelling](#) commissioned by the New Zealand government to estimate the potential impact of the new measures.

Further afield, activity to support progressing a tobacco endgame increased globally. On World No Tobacco Day, the Tobacco-Free Ireland Programme launched a Tobacco Free Ireland Plan and Tobacco Endgame report at their [Tobacco Endgame Conference](#). A [Tobacco Endgame Hub](#) was established in India in 2022 with support from the International Union against TB and Lung Diseases. In Spain, the [6th ICO-WHO Symposium on Tobacco Control](#) featured multiple sessions on how tobacco control policies globally are shifting to a tobacco endgame. Other international progress

includes the Massachusetts Supreme Court's dismissal of a legal challenge to the City of Brookline's Tobacco Free Generation law. These are only a handful of examples.

Against this background, it is exciting to see the Tobacco Endgame CRE ramping up its research, research training and knowledge translation activities. Our first EMCR symposium, held in September 2022, showcased the impressive range of studies being undertaken by the CRE's EMCRs and included presentations from research students, EMCRs, senior researchers and government partners. We added 4 new higher degree research students, bringing our higher degree research student cohort to 16. We also supervised two Honours student projects and three Master of Public Health research projects, and five short student projects. Our researchers and affiliates produced over 190 peer-reviewed tobacco-related publications and multiple knowledge translation products (20 blog articles, three podcasts, six government consultation submissions), and contributed to multiple mainstream media reports. We also completed a major data collection with the 2022 wave of the International Tobacco Control Policy Evaluation Project cohort. These outcomes and activities are detailed in this annual report.

Next year is shaping up to be even more productive with new funding totalling over \$6.6M already secured this year to expand our research program over the next five years. This includes the establishment of the International Tobacco Endgame Research Network via a NHMRC Synergy Grant to expand our global collaboration, two ARC Research Fellowships (a Future Fellowship and a Discovery Early Career Researcher Award), and a NHMRC PhD scholarship. Finally, I would like to thank all our EMCRs, particularly the organising committee for the EMCR symposium, our affiliates, chief and associate investigators, government and non-government collaborators and our funders for their support and contributions to what has been a very productive year. I look forward to continuing to collaborate with you as we enter our third year.

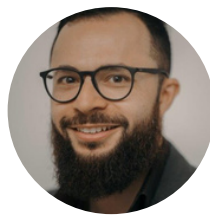

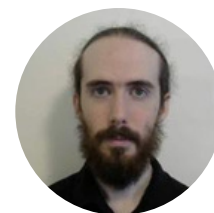

# RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

## Announcing the Interdisciplinary Tobacco Endgame Research Network, funded by a NHMRC Synergy grant

The Tobacco Endgame CRE is excited to announce the formation of the Interdisciplinary Tobacco Endgame Research Network (INTER-Net), commencing in 2023. This multidisciplinary research program, funded by a NHMRC Synergy grant, will examine promising new approaches to minimising smoking in Australia using methods from epidemiology and applied statistics, health policy, law, the social sciences, and economics. The grant will be led by Prof Coral Gartner, with other Chief Investigators including Prof Geoffrey Fong, Prof Janet Hoek, Prof Brigit Toebe, Dr Gary Chan, Dr Kylie Morphett, Dr Daniel Erku, A/Prof Marita Hefler, Prof Ron Borland, and A/Prof Joshua Byrnes. ## Scalable Health Intervention Evaluation (SHINE)

The Scalable Health Intervention Evaluation (SHINE) program led by Tobacco Endgame CRE CI Professor Tony Blakely has provided highly influential modelling, co-led by CRE member Dr Driss Ait Ouakrim, to the New Zealand Government on the health and cost impacts of tobacco endgame strategies that the NZ Government is now legislating for, namely: denicotinising all retailed tobacco to minimal levels (maximum 0.8mg/g); 90-95% reduction in tobacco retail outlets; and making it illegal to sell tobacco to anyone born in 2009 or later (the so-called tobacco-free generation). Massive health gains and reductions in Maori: non-Maori health inequalities will result.

Australian tobacco control experts are already saying "why not here too?", noting the massive potential to reduce Indigenous health inequalities in Australia. Professor Blakely says "Our NZ modelling is just one example of the power and utility of SHINE modelling for public health planning and policy. We are currently assessing many tobacco control programs, healthy housing interventions, COVID-19 policies, and other prevention programs."



## Latest wave of ITC data collection complete

Data collection for the latest wave of the International Tobacco Control (ITC) Policy Evaluation Project is now complete. The ITC Project is the first-ever international cohort study of tobacco use, and has completed data collection in 31 countries so far, inhabited by >50% of the world's population, >60% of the people who smoke, and >70% of people who use tobacco in any form globally. The Australian arm of the Project is led by Prof Coral Gartner.

CRE investigator, A/Prof Andrew Waa will present on "Eliminating smoking inequities by pursuing an end for commercial tobacco: The experience of New Zealand Māori" as part of the **Envisioning an equitable commercial tobacco endgame** Symposium. The conference will be held in San Antonio in the USA from 1-4 March 2023.

## Government Submissions

In 2022, CRE researchers contributed to six submissions to government. Highlights include:

1. In March 2022, CRE researchers drafted a submission on the proposed **National Tobacco Strategy 2022-2030**. The submission called on the Australian government to implement innovative new endgame policies, provide clear timeframes for each proposed action with clear governance and responsibility, regular monitoring and reporting of progress concerning smoking prevalence and policy implementation with financial support for at least biennial national data collections.
2. In June 2022, CRE researchers made a submission to the **Queensland Government Consultation Regulatory Impact Statement - Reducing the negative effects of smoking in Queensland**. The submission outlined recommendations for a licensing scheme for smoking product suppliers, and recommended restrictions on the number of tobacco retailers, compliance with the provisions of the WHO Protocol to Eliminate Illicit Trade in Tobacco Products, the implementation of further restrictions on tobacco advertising and promotion, and reduced public access to tobacco vending machines.
3. In August 2022, CRE researchers made a submission to **Consultation on New Zealand's Proposed Smokefree 2025 Legislation**. The submission highlighted the importance of Māori governance of the tobacco control system being designed and implemented by Māori people, the benefit of engagement with a broad range of community organisations and financial investment in these organisations to contribute to community-based initiatives to achieve the Smokefree 2025 goal, the need for a well-planned and adequately resourced independent research and evaluation program, and a recommendation to prepare and to provide sufficient support for strong, persuasive, and widely disseminated public education campaigns to counteract industry rhetoric and misinformation, and to expose the actions of the tobacco industry that are against the interests of New Zealanders' health and well-being.

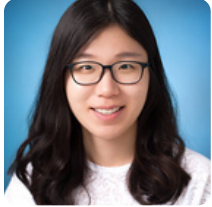
## SRNT University Guided Tour

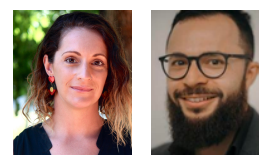

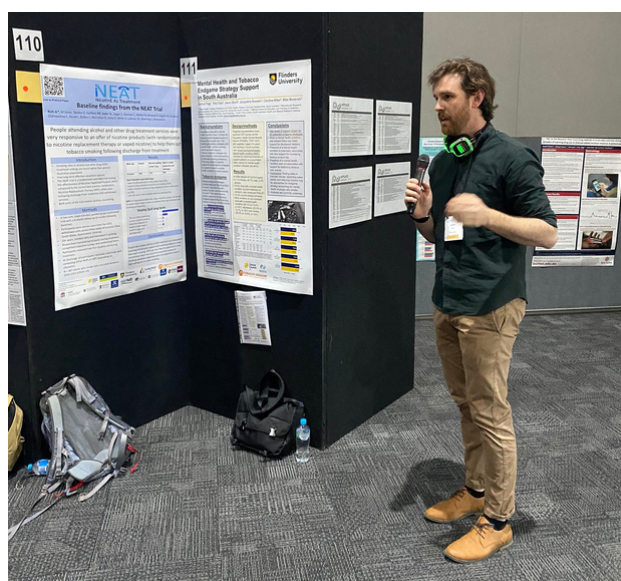

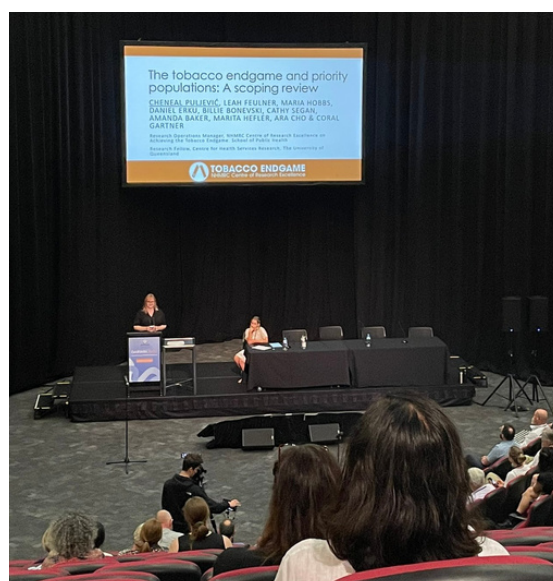
